#### PURPOSE OF THE ORGANIZATION

The Canadian Association of Psychoanalytic Child Therapists (the "organization") is a not-for-profit organization of Ontario. As a registered charity the organization is exempt from the payment of income tax under Subsection 149(1) of the Income Tax Act.

#### 2. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

- accounts receivable less an allowance for doubtful accounts
